SPECIAL COURSE, BUDO SPECIALIZATION PROGRAM



The Budo Specialization Program is designed for foreign students of Budo (Judo or Kendo). Budo training includes instruction in both theory and practical exercises. Japanese culture and Japanese language instruction are included in the basic curriculum. Students are expected to gain a level of Japanese proficiency sufficient for participation in the university's lectures and enter the undergraduate or graduate school of IBU. The aim of the Budo Specialization Program is to develop specialists who will conserve and promote Budo and thereby contribute to the global development of the international society.

Upon completion of the program students may receive recommendations for admission to the university's undergraduate and graduate programs.

**Qualification:** Applicants must be foreign registered with non-Japanese nationality, who are eligible for entry to university.

**Selection Process:** By application.

**Course period:** 1 year (April through March).

**Accommodation:** On campus dormitory housing or apartment.

**Scholarship system:** Available for some students for 1 year.

**Health insurance system:** Available.

Students can refine their skills by participation in the club training.
