Date, time and place

Saturday and Sunday the 15th and 16th of august 2026, see program below.

Saturday program (approximate times)

08:30 - 09:30	Assembly of the dojo
09:30 - 10:00	Opening and yawatashi
10:00 - 12:00	Gasshuku
12:00 - 13:00	Lunch (bring your own lunch and beverage)
13:00 - 17:00	Grading, Swedish cup nr 3 and award ceremony*
17:00	End of the day

*The afternoon is dedicated to the kyu grading and the Swedish cup primarily. There will be time for a break and fika during this time, around 15:00 or when time permits it.

The award ceremony will be held after the both the kyu grading and Swedish cup are completed. The dojo will be open for everyone if there is time left after the ceremony.

Registration is handled on a rolling basis when participants arrive at the dojo.

NOTE! Participants who are joining the grading or the Swedish cup are required to be ready with their training clothes and equipment when the respective event starts.

Sunday program (approximate times)

09:00 - 09:15	Opening
09:15 - 12:00	Gasshuku
12:00 - 13:00	Lunch (bring your own lunch and beverage)
13:00 - 17:00	Afternoon practice**
17:00	Closing ceremony and disassembly of the dojo

**The Sunday afternoon practice can be done in two different ways. This is dependent on the distribution between the participants who are joining the national team practice or the gasshuku.

Option A:

We split the shajo in two where the national team will practice on mato (target) 1-3, and the gasshuku on mato 4-6. Practice on mato 4-6 is open for everyone present.

Option B:

All the matos are dedicated for the national team practice only.

NOTE! The decision on which option for the Sunday afternoon practice will be decided and announced on Saturday.

Gasshuku info

Requirements:

- Participants are required to wear traditional training clothes: black hakama, keikogi, and white tabis (all grades).
 - Participant who doesn't have traditional training clothes should wear a white t-shirt, black pants and white socks.
- The gasshuku is only open for the kyudo members of the Swedish Kendo federation.

Other info

Participants who are not able to perform zasha (sitting shooting) should report this when they register for the gasshuku by mail. A medical certificate needs to be presented in person at the event registration on the location.

The usual dojo rules are applied at this gasshuku.

Lunch & snack

Lunches are not included in the event, please bring your own food, beverage and snack. There are stores and restaurants nearby the gasshuku facility.

Saturday dinner

There will be a dinner for everyone who can and wants to join. Everyone who joins are responsible for their own costs.

Overnight stay

The overnight stay in relation to the gasshuku is not included. Everyone who are staying in Linköping are responsible for their own cost.

Gasshuku fee and payment

The fee is 100 SEK / per person for participating in the parts of the event which are for the gasshuku. The cost is the same regardless of the amounts of days participating.

The fee is paid to Linköpings Budo Club/Kendosektionen, Bankgiro 5346 1927 or swish 123 452 57 21. Write "Kyudo gasshuku" with the payment. This payment shall be paid before the end of the event.

Grading

Registration for the grading should be sent in at the latest **1st of August**. Send the registration to **Kyudo@linkopingbudo.se** with the information below:

- Name
- Club
- Place of birth (and which country if its outside of Sweden)
- Date of birth (YYYY-MM-DD)
- Which grade that you want to apply for.
- Current grade

NOTE! The Kendo Federation's grading paper form that was previously used is no longer needed.

It is also a written exam for those who are applying for 1st kyu. The participant should have the written exam ready before the event and hand it in to the judges during the kyu grading. It is allowed to use reference material such as books, notes or the internet.

The exam must be written in a language that the judges understand, it is recommended to do it in Swedish or English. Please mention in the registration mail if you wish to write in a language that is not Swedish or English. It is not a guarantee that your language of choice is possible.

The grading fee is 200 SEK regardless of grade and is paid to Linköpings Budo Club/Kendosektionen, Bankgiro 5346 1927 or swish 123 452 57 21 at the latest **18th of August**. Write "Kyudo kyugradering" with the payment.

Swedish Cup

Registration is due no later than the **8th of August** at e-mail to **Kyudo@linkopingbudo.se** (write name and club).

The Swedish Cup is open to anyone who can perform with two arrows at 28m (the same requirements for 2 kyu grade).

The competition is decided in three rounds of four arrows each. There will be two warm up arrows before the competition. The competition fee is 30 SEK and is paid on site with Swish or cash (even money). Write "Kyudo Svenska Cupen" when paying with Swish.

Bus

Buses are available with the company Östgötatrafiken. The closest stop is called “Hangaren” which can be accessed with bus line 3. Route information can be found on the company’s web page or app. Tickets can be bought from the company’s web page, app or by credit card directly in the bus.
